**Questions to Consider**  
**Weekend of February 20 & 21, 2010**

1. Abram moved and left all that was familiar when he clearly heard the voice of God. How difficult is it for you at times to move in faith when that move takes you from the familiar and comfortable things of your life?
  
2. Abraham was called many things including a "friend of God". Over and over, Abraham was able to demonstrate his trust in God. How do you think Abraham's faith and trust in God proved his friendship with God? Are you and God good friends?
  
3. Abraham was a part of God's plan and was going to be used in great ways, yet he still faced hard times with the famine. When have you been right with God yet still had hard times? How did God come through for you?
  
4. Is God more evident in your life during the good times or during the hard times? Why is this? What can we do to have God evident in our life during *all* times?
  
5. Do you think Abraham understood the blessing and responsibility of the blessing at the time God spoke it? Why or why not?
  
6. God said He was going to bless Abraham so he could be a blessing to others. That blessing flows down to us today as followers of Christ. Why is it important for us today to live our lives in such a way as to bless others? How are you doing that? How do you see The Grove living this out?
