Questions to Consider
Weekend Message of January 16 & 17, 2010

1. Knowing right from wrong, what temptations come and reside in your life? Do we entertain them out of a desire to do wrong or just to “flirt” with the excitement and thrill of knowing they are wrong but feel good? Is it still wrong to just think the thoughts and never act on them?

2. God allowed Adam and Eve to be tested in the garden. Why does God allow us to be tested? What have you discovered about yourself through testing?

3. We see Adam passing blame of his sin to Eve. We see Eve passing blame of her sin to the serpent. Do we blame anyone for our sin?

4. Read verses 1-7 and write down the tactics Satan used to lead Adam and Eve to sin. Does he still use those tactics today? How can we prepare ourselves to not to fall to his trickery?

5. God gave everyone free choice. Was that wise of Him to do so? Why or why not?

6. Genesis 3:8 shows Adam and Eve hiding from God. Can we really hide from God? Can we hide our sin from Him? Why do we try at times to do so?

7. Can we make a great decision to live a truly Christian life? If so where would you start? What actions would support this decision?
