

**Shape Up to Ship Out**  
**Genesis 6-7**  
**Questions to Consider**  
**Weekend Message of January 30 & 31, 2010**

1. It is almost impossible to believe that the incomprehensibly huge heart of God could be filled with pain, yet that is what Genesis 6 tells us. What actions have you done even this week that have grieved the heart of God?
  
2. Noah was righteous and blameless. How did he achieve that standing with God? How do we not achieve that standing?
  
3. Noah performed the task at hand and completed it allowing God to close him into the ark, not knowing the duration and even if he was to ever be on dry land again. How hard is it to allow God to direct us into a new venture without needing to know the outcome?
  
4. Noah worked on the ark for over 120 years as God waited patiently. Do we as believers spend more time working on the task of reaching others or just waiting inside the ark?
  
5. The flood waters literally lifted the ark while the destruction of the world was happening around it. When has God in His mercy raised you above the mess of the world going on around you?
  
6. How does the ark represent God's provision for the world today?
  
7. In verse 6:9, Noah was given the title that he "Walked with God." Is there a time when you could wear that title? What do you have to do to regain that title? Who do you have to talk with or what circumstances need to change in your life to "Walk with God?"
