

**Covenant God**  
**Genesis 8 and 9**  
**Questions to Consider**  
**Weekend message of February 6 & 7, 2010**

1. God's covenant with Noah was based on His nature alone to fulfill. What has God promised you that He alone will do? Can you trust God to fulfill those promises?
2. God "remembered" Noah, although it may have seemed like He forgot Noah after a year in the ark. God knows where we are *all* the time and at the perfect time He "remembers" and shows up with our provision. God is never late. What has God remembered in your life and how has your dependence on Him grown?
3. Noah sent out several birds to see if it was safe to leave the ark. The raven continued to fly around even without a safe place to land. The dove was sent out and returned to Noah. What does this picture of dependence of the dove tell you about how God wants to care for you, especially when we have no place to land?
4. One of the first things Noah did after exiting the ark was an act of worship for God's amazing deliverance. What has God delivered you from that you need to stop and thank Him for?
5. Life is sacred and God will hold us responsible for this. How do you see people in our country not valuing another human's life?
6. Ham didn't value the "dignity" of his father. Why has the dignity of people today become so misunderstood? How can we improve in this area?
