

Didn't happen all at once but slowly over time, until they had no true spiritual life left. They had blended into culture so much; they didn't even know they were far from God.

2 They will be exposed to the sun and the moon and all the stars of the heavens, which they have loved and served

and which they have followed and consulted and worshiped.

They will not be gathered up or buried, but will be like dung lying on the ground.

3 Wherever I banish them, all the survivors of this evil nation will prefer death to life, declares the Lord Almighty.'

God didn't want to do this; they chose to have Him do this with their continual disobedience.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

Has there ever been a time when we pushed God far enough, where He could be close to saying of us – enough is enough?

Have you ever drifted from God? What safeguards have you put in your life to make sure this doesn't happen? (It happens slowly, until we like Judah, look just like the culture around us.)

4 "Say to them, 'This is what the Lord says: "When people fall down, do they not get up?

When someone turns away, do they not return?

5 Why then have these people turned away? Why does Jerusalem always turn away?

They cling to deceit; they refuse to return. 6 I have listened attentively, but they do not say what is right.

None of them repent of their wickedness, saying, "What have I done?"

Each pursues their own course like a horse charging into battle.


7 Even the stork in the sky knows her appointed seasons, and the dove, the swift and the thrush observe the time of their migration.


But my people do not know the requirements of the Lord.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

Forgiven people can still come to church with wrong motives and bring God insincere worship. What kind of worship did you bring Jesus today?

8 "How can you say, "We are wise, for we have the law of the Lord," when actually the lying pen of the scribes has handled it falsely?

When God's Word is not the "standard", there is no standard anymore, and anything can be truth.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

How easy is it for us to drown out the voice of God? Have you ever asked, how in the world can a believer act like that and think it is ok? Or better yet ask that question of ourselves. How could I have ever gotten myself to this place, involved in behavior like this?

The God they once loved and worshiped was now in their minds smaller than the gods they carved and created.

JEREMIAH 9:24 (NIV)

but let the one who boasts boast about this: that they have the understanding to know me, that I am the Lord,

who exercises kindness, justice and righteousness on earth, for in these I delight," declares the Lord.

"So, the idea behind boasting is what you project, what you want people to perceive about you. This is your boast.

Someone who has been close to God has a sense of perspective.

They know exactly how small they are compared to God.

No one brags in God's presence."

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

Has something gone haywire in our thinking here on earth where we have elevated ourselves and our worth, thinking that we could do, or accomplish anything apart from God's great mercy, love, and blessing on us?

How can this happen to us today?

1 CORINTHIANS 1:28-31 (NIV)

28 God chose the lowly things of this world and the despised things—and the things that are not—to nullify the things that are,

29 so that no one may boast before him. 30 It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God—


1 CORINTHIANS 1:28-31 (NIV)
