11 things Jesus said to **prepare us for the end:**

Mark 13:3-13

1. **See that no one leads you astray.**
2. **Do not be alarmed.**
3. **Be on your guard.**
4. **The Gospel must first be proclaimed to all nations.**
5. **Do not be anxious.**
6. **The one who endures to the end will be saved.**

7. **Be on guard; I have told you all things beforehand.**

Mark 13:24-27

8. **They will see the Son of Man coming in clouds with great power and glory.**
