



DAY 1 The Triumphal Entry

READ Matthew 21:1-11 and Zechariah 9:9.

The people were so excited for Jesus's arrival to Jerusalem that they laid down their cloaks and palm branches shouting "Hosanna! Hosanna!" Hosanna means 'save us." The people had been waiting and waiting for hundreds of years for their promised Messiah to come and save them. The people expected a warrior king to come in on a horse to save them from the hand of Rome. In order to fulfill the prophecy, we read about in Zechariah 9.9, Jesus rode in on a donkey - which symbolized peace. Jesus did come to save them, but He had a bigger and much better plan.
