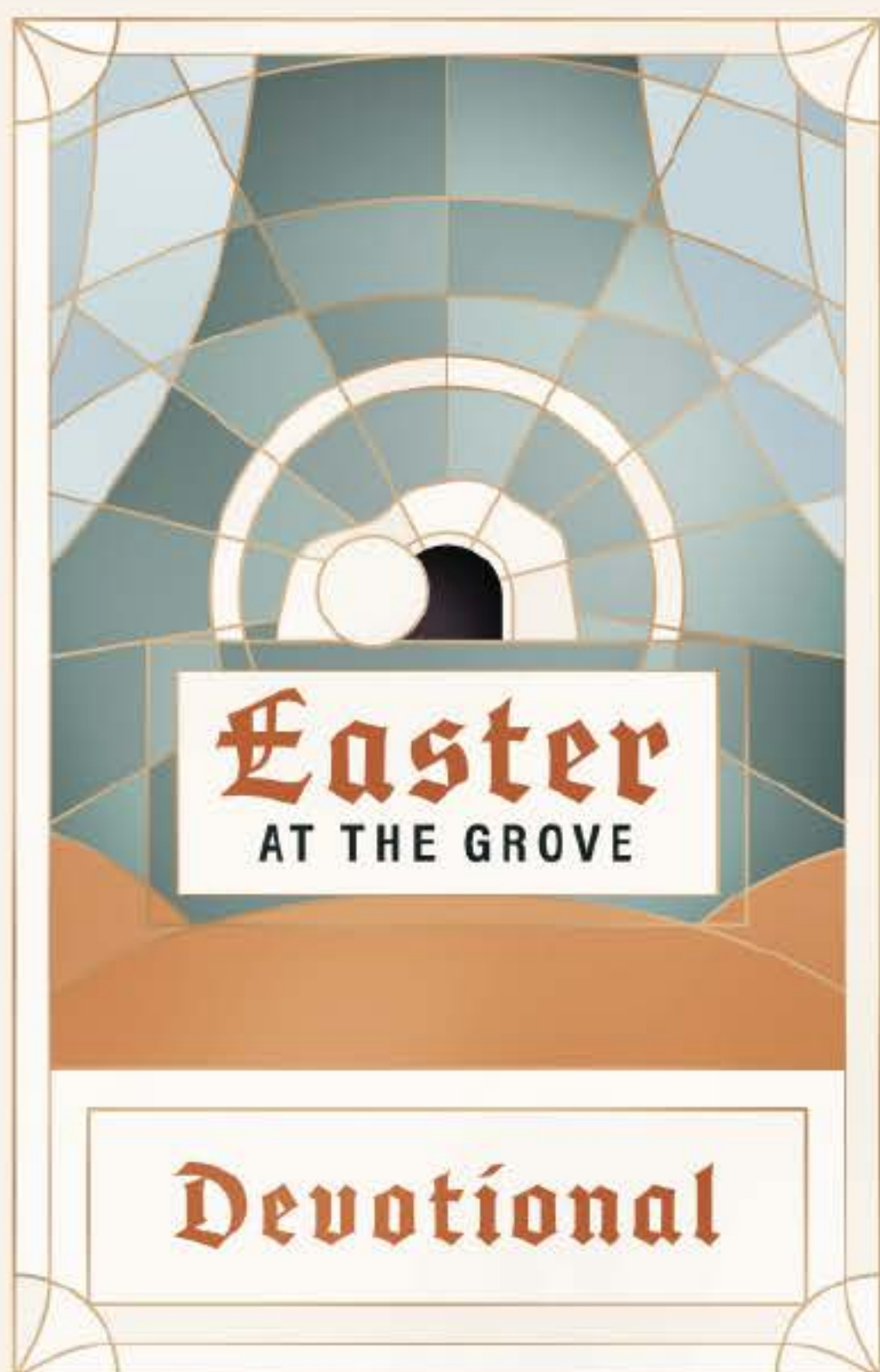

**DAY 1**  
**The Triumphal Entry**

**READ Matthew 21:1-11 and Zechariah 9:9.**  
The people were so excited for Jesus's arrival to Jerusalem that they laid down their cloaks and palm branches shouting "Hosanna! Hosanna!" Hosanna means 'save us.' The people had been waiting and waiting for hundreds of years for their promised Messiah to come and save them. The people expected a warrior king to come in on a horse to save them from the hand of Rome. In order to fulfill the prophecy, we read about in Zechariah 9:9, Jesus rode in on a donkey — which symbolized peace. Jesus did come to save them, but He had a bigger and much better plan.

**ASK**

- What is something you are excited about for Easter?
- Why was Jesus' plan better?
- How can your family serve Jesus this week?

**PRAY**  
Dear God, Thank you so much for being the King of Kings that came to save us so many years ago. God, thank you for fulfilling the prophecy and showing us that You are true to Your Word. Lord, You came in a way the people didn't expect to do something bigger than they could imagine. Thank you for Your great plan to save us so that we can know You. In Jesus's name, we pray, Amen.

**DO**  
Trace your hands on paper, color it green, cut out the hands and glue to a stick. Have a parade in your front room, and shout, "Hosanna! Hosanna!"
