#### A Living Hope Jeremiah 29:4-14

But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they went to the tomb, taking the spices they had prepared.

<sup>2</sup> And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, <sup>3</sup> but when they went in they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus.

4 While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men stood by them in dazzling apparel.

5 And as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead?

6 He is not here, but has risen. Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee,

7 that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men and be crucified and on the third day rise."

8 And they remembered his words, 9 and returning from the tomb they told all these things to the eleven and to all the rest.

10 Now it was Mary Magdalene and Joanna and Mary the mother of James and the other women with them who told these things

to the apostles, 11 but these words seemed to them an idle tale, and they did not believe them.

12 But Peter rose and ran to the tomb; stooping and looking in, he saw the linen cloths by themselves;

## Luke 24:1-12 (ESV) and he went home marveling at what had happened.

## 1 Peter 1:3-4 (NIV) 3 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ!

#### 1 Peter 1:3-4 (NIV)

In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a <u>living hope</u> through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

4 and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade.

This inheritance is kept in heaven for you.

The Greek term for "hope" in the passage means "an eager, confident expectation."

### Ecclesiastes 9:4 (ESV)

Anyone who is among the living has hope—even a live dog is better off than a dead lion!

These are the words of the letter that Jeremiah the prophet sent from Jerusalem to the surviving elders of the exiles, and to the priests,

the prophets, and all the people, whom Nebuchadnezzar had taken into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon.

<sup>4</sup> "Thus says the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel, to all the exiles whom I have sent into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon:

- 5 Build houses and live in them; plant gardens and eat their produce.
- 6 Take wives and have sons and daughters; take wives for your sons,

and give your daughters in marriage, that they may bear sons and daughters; multiply there, and do not decrease.

<sup>7</sup> But seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the Lord on its behalf,


Jeremiah 29:4-10 (ESV) for in its welfare you will find your welfare.

8 For thus says the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel: Do not let your prophets and your diviners who are among you deceive you,

and do not listen to the dreams that they dream, 9 for it is a lie that they are prophesying to you in my name; I did not send them,


