1 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses,

let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles.

And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, 2 fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith.

For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

3 Consider him who endured such opposition from sinners, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.

THE END Jeremiah 39-43, 46-52

#### JEREMIAH 1:5 (ESV)

I knew you before I formed you in your mother's womb. Before you were born I set you apart and appointed you as my prophet to the nations.

#### JEREMIAH 1:19 (ESV)

They will fight against you, but they shall not prevail against you, for I am with you, declares the Lord to deliver you.

#### **JEREMIAH 39:11-12 (ESV)**

<sup>11</sup> Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon gave command concerning Jeremiah through Nebuzaradan, the captain of the guard, saying,

#### **JEREMIAH 39:11-12 (ESV)**

12 "Take him, look after him well, and do him no harm, but deal with him as he tells you."

The word that came to Jeremiah from the Lord after Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had let him go from Ramah,

when he took him bound in chains along with all the captives of Jerusalem and Judah who were being exiled to Babylon.

<sup>2</sup> The captain of the guard took Jeremiah and said to him, "The Lord your God pronounced this disaster against this place.

3 The Lord has brought it about, and has done as he said.

Because you sinned against the Lord and did not obey his voice, this thing has come upon you.

4 Now, behold, I release you today from the chains on your hands. If it seems good to you to come with me to Babylon, come,

and I will look after you well, but if it seems wrong to you to come with me to Babylon, do not come.

See, the whole land is before you; go wherever you think it good and right to go.

5 If you remain, then return to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, son of Shaphan, whom the king of Babylon appointed governor of the cities

of Judah, and dwell with him among the people.

Or go wherever you think it right to go."

So the captain of the guard gave him an allowance of food and a present, and let him go.

<sup>6</sup> Then Jeremiah went to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, at Mizpah, and lived with him among the people who were left in the land.

10 If you will remain in this land, then I will build you up and not pull you down; I will plant you, and not pluck you up;

for I relent of the disaster that I did to you.

11 Do not fear the king of Babylon, of whom you are afraid.

Do not fear him, declares the Lord,

for I am with you, to save you and to deliver you from his hand.

12 I will grant you mercy, that he may have mercy on you and let you remain in your own land.

13 But if you say, 'We will not remain in this land,' disobeying the voice of the Lord your God 14 and saying,

'No, we will go to the land of Egypt, where we shall not see war or hear the sound of the trumpet or be hungry for bread,

and we will dwell there,' 15 then hear the word of the Lord, O remnant of Judah. Thus says the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel:

If you set your faces to enter Egypt and go to live there, 16 then the sword that you fear shall overtake you there in the land of Egypt,

and the famine of which you are afraid shall follow close after you to Egypt, and there you shall die.

### **JEREMIAH 1:9-10 (ESV)**


10 See, I have set you this day over nations and over kingdoms, to pluck up and to break down, to destroy and to overthrow, to build and to plant."
