complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind.

PHILIPPIANS 2:5-8 (ESV)

5 Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, 6 who, though he was in the form of God,

PHILIPPIANS 2:5-8 (ESV)

did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant,

PHILIPPIANS 2:5-8 (ESV) being born in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in human form,

PHILIPPIANS 2:5-8 (ESV)

he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

C.S. Lewis calls pride "the great sin."

"There is one vice of which no man in the world is free; which every one in the world loathes when he sees it in

C.S. LEWIS someone else...The vice I am talking of is Pride or Self-Conceit;

and the virtue opposite to it, in Christian morals is called Humility."

According to Christian teachers, the essential vice, the utmost evil, is Pride.

Unchastity, anger, greed, drunkenness, and all that, are mere flea bites in comparison:

C.S. LEWIS it was through Pride that the devil became the devil:

Pride leads to every other vice: it is the complete anti-God state of mind.

"Christians are right: it is Pride which has been the chief cause of misery

C.S. LEWIS in every nation and every family since world began."

c. Look to the interests of others.

Look: σκοπός: skopos

"Do not imagine that if you meet a really humble man he will be what most people call humble nowadays:

he will not be a sort of greasy, smarmy person, who is always telling you that, of course, he is nobody.

Probably all you will think about him is that he seemed a cheerful, intelligent chap who took a real interest in what you

said to him. If you do dislike him it will be because you feel a little envious of anyone who seems to enjoy life so easily.

He will not be thinking about humility: he will not be thinking about himself at all."

MATTHEW 5:16 (ESV)

In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works

MATTHEW 5:16 (ESV) and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.
