JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

35 The next day again John was standing
with two of his disciples,

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

36 and he looked at Jesus as he walked by
and said, “Behold, the Lamb of God!”

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

37 The two disciples heard him say this,
and they followed Jesus.

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

38 Jesus turned and saw them following and said to them,
“What are you seeking?”

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

And they said to him, “Rabbi” (which means Teacher), “where are you staying?”³⁹ He said to them, “Come and you will see.”

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

So they came and saw where he was staying,
and they stayed with him that day, for it was about the tenth hour.

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

40 One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

41 He first found his own brother Simon and said to him,
“We have found the Messiah” (which means Christ).

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

42 He brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said,
“You are Simon the son of John.

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

You shall be called Cephas”
(which means Peter).

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

43 The next day Jesus decided to go to Galilee.
He found Philip and said to him, "Follow me."

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

44 Now Philip was from Bethsaida,
the city of Andrew and Peter.

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

45 Philip found Nathanael and said to him, “We have found him of whom Moses in the Law and also the prophets wrote,

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.”⁴⁶ Nathanael said to him,
“Can anything good come out of Nazareth?”

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

Philip said to him, “Come and see.”

47 Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward him and said of him,

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

“Behold, an Israelite indeed, in whom there is no deceit!”

48 Nathanael said to him, “How do you know me?”

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

Jesus answered him, “Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you.”

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

49 Nathanael answered him, “Rabbi, you are the Son of God!
You are the King of Israel!”

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

50 Jesus answered him, “Because I said to you,
‘I saw you under the fig tree,’ do you believe?”

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

You will see greater things than these.”⁵¹ And he said to him,
“Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see heaven opened,

JOHN 1:35-51 (ESV)

and the angels of God ascending
and descending on the Son of Man.”
