A WORTHY PLAN PHILIPPIANS 1:1-2 (PART 1); ACTS 16:1-15

PHILIPPIANS 1:27 (ESV)

Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent,

PHILIPPIANS 1:27 (ESV)

I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving side by side for the faith of the gospel,

PHILIPPIANS 1:1-2 (ESV)

Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus, To all the saints in Christ Jesus who are at Philippi, with the overseers and deacons:

PHILIPPIANS 1:1-2 (ESV)

² Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Paul came also to Derbe and to Lystra. A disciple was there, named Timothy, the son of a Jewish woman who was a believer,

but his father was a Greek. 2 He was well spoken of by the brothers at Lystra and Iconium. 3 Paul wanted Timothy to accompany him,

and he took him and circumcised him because of the Jews who were in those places, for they all knew that his father was a Greek.

4 As they went on their way through the cities, they delivered to them for observance the decisions that had been reached by the

apostles and elders who were in Jerusalem. 5 So the churches were strengthened in the faith, and they increased in numbers daily.

PROVERBS 19:21 (ESV)


Many are the plans in a person's heart, but it is the LORD's purpose that prevails.

11 So, setting sail from Troas, we made a direct voyage to Samothrace, and the following day to Neapolis,

and from there to Philippi, which is a leading city of the district of Macedonia and a Roman colony.

We remained in this city some days. 13 And on the Sabbath day we went outside the gate to the riverside,

where we supposed there was a place of prayer, and we sat down and spoke to the women who had come together.

14 One who heard us was a woman named Lydia, from the city of Thyatira, a seller of purple goods, who was a worshiper of God.

The Lord opened her heart to pay attention to what was said by Paul. 15 And after she was baptized, and her household as well,

she urged us, saying, "If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come to my house and stay." And she prevailed upon us.
