	Romans 1:18-25 ¹⁸ The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of people, who suppress the truth by their wickedness, ¹⁹ since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. ²⁰ For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse. ²¹ For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became futile and their foolish hearts were darkened. ²² Although they claimed to be wise, they became fools ²³ and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images made to look like a mortal human being

Fossil Evidence

♦ Neanderthal Man Well-developed around art/culture/religion. Skeletal Deformities (lack of iodine?) Men living in caves.

♦ <u>Piltdown Man</u> (1912-1950) A hoax...stained for age and filed teeth

♦ Java Man
Only a skull cap and femer found by Eugene DuBois, But also found a

human skull at the same level but kept secret for 30 years.

♦ Nebraska Man Tooth of an extinct pig, but drew skull, jaw, and family

♦ Ramapithecus (1979) reconstructed a 'biped' with only teeth and a jaw

Leaky's find in Africa...rhinos, boas, hippos, monkeys, NO apes AND tools
 13 years later Leaky's son said bones were virtually indistinguishable from humans

3. Our Choice

John 3:19-21 This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. ²⁰ Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed. ²¹ But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what they have done has been done in the sight of God.

Colossians 1:16-17 For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. ¹⁷ He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

Hebrews 11:3 By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.

Revelation 4:11 "You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being."
